


1 COVERING

Use paper or cut out pictures from magazines to cover the outside of cardboard boxes. Just glue them on!



2 CUT AND FOLD

Cut shapes out of flat pieces of cardboard, or fold and bend cardboard into the shapes you need to build with.






AMAZING things YOU CAN DO WITH

INTERLOCKING

To make two flat pieces of cardboard stand up, you can cut slots in the top of one piece and the bottom of another (as shown here). Then slide them together!





4 LAYERING

Glue several flat pieces of cardboard on top of each other to make a much stronger piece. This can be helpful if you're building something large or tall.



PAPER LUNCH BAG OR GROCERY BAG

STEP TWO


After you are finished with your cuts, open up the bag.

Hold the bottom of the bag as you twist the middle of the bag to form the trunk

of your tree.

STEP ONE

Begin with your paper bag flat & use scissors to make several long cuts from the top (open end)





STEP THREE

Now twist each individual cut strip to create branches for your tree.

Feel free to use take to hold things in place.



STEP FOUR

Cut or tear leaf shapes out of construction paper & add them to your branches.
